GAMES HAVE BEEN IN
NEW ZEALAND 3 TIMES:
1950 > AUCKLAND
1974 > CHRISTCHURCH
1990 > AUCKLAND

- The games started in 1930, and people from over 50 countries compete at them
- **The Commonwealth Games are held every 4 years**
- They are like the Olympics, but only countries that are part of the Commonwealth of Nations can enter
- **The Commonwealth Games are on this year from 3 - 14 October**
- Many athletes compete in different events, like netball, athletics, lawn bowls, and archery
- **The mascot for the games is a tiger called Shera**
- Tennis will be played at the 2010 Commonwealth Games for the first ever time
- **Medals are awarded to the people that come first, second and third.**

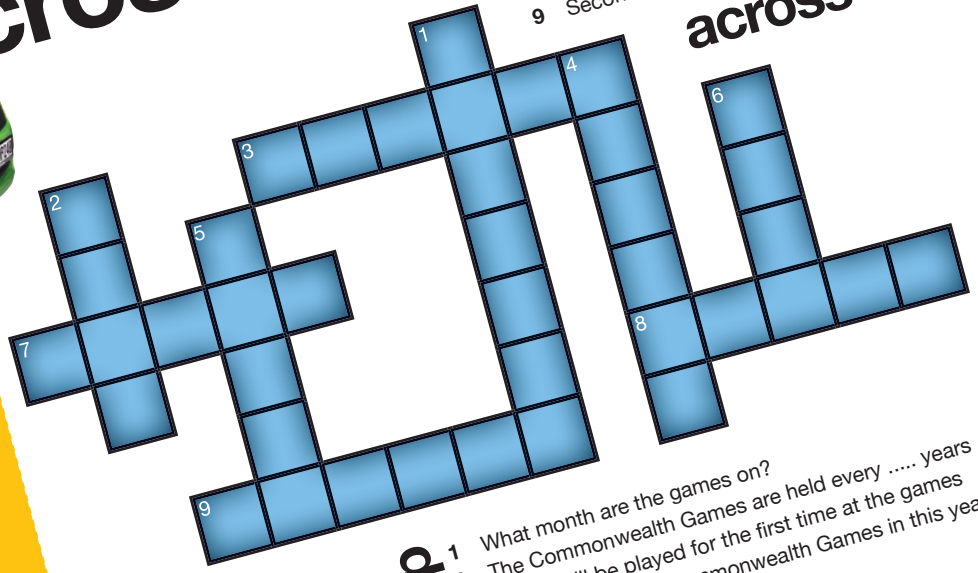
