Waitangi Day

6 FEB

On February 6 we commemorate the signing of the Treaty of Waitangi, New Zealand's founding document, between Māori chiefs and British representatives of the Crown.

The treaty was signed in 1840, at James Busby's house (now known as Treaty House) at Waitangi township in the Bay of Islands. Since 1974, the day has been officially celebrated as a public holiday and New Zealand's national day.

Around 500 chiefs signed the Treaty. Māori Chief Hone Heke was the first to sign and as they were signing they said "He iwi tahi tatou", which when translated into English means "We are now one people".

Waitangi celebrations begin the previous day at the Ngapuhi Te Tii marae. The Royal New Zealand Navy raises the national flag, the Union Jack, and St. George's Ensign on the flagstaff in the treaty grounds. Cultural song and dance displays and a re-enactment of the signing of the treaty are part of this traditional ceremony.



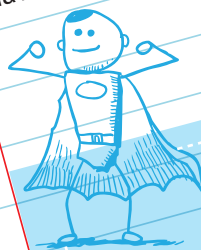
