## 2015 cricket world cup

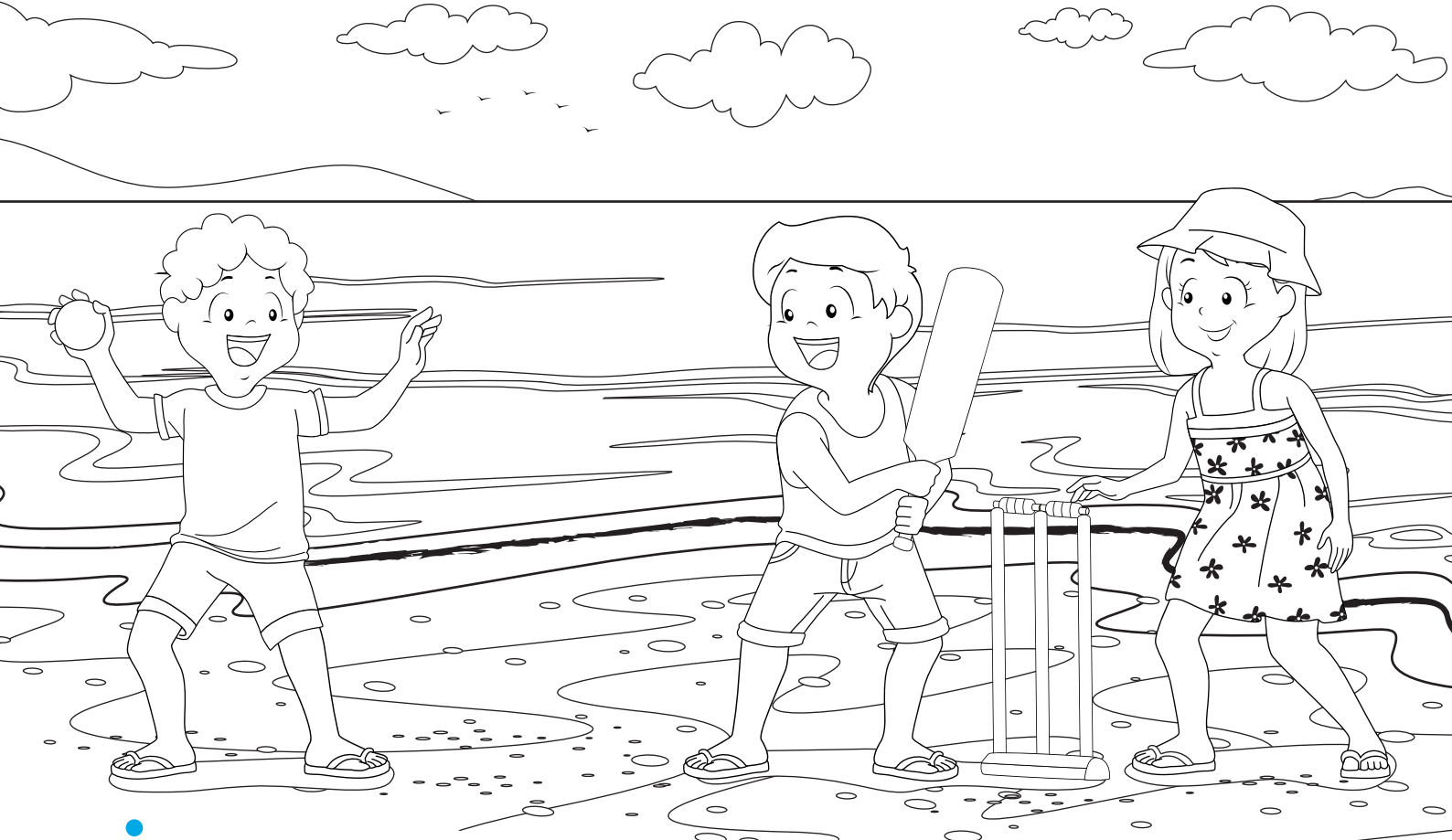
THE ICC CRICKET WORLD CUP IS ONE OF THE WORLD'S BIGGEST SPORTING EVENTS AND THIS TIME IT IS BEING HELD RIGHT HERE IN NEW ZEALAND AND AUSTRALIA FROM 14TH FEBRUARY TO 29TH MARCH, 2015.

- The first tournament took place in England in 1975 which was won by the West Indies. The most recent event was held in 2011 which was won by India, who hosted the tournament along with Bangladesh and Sri Lanka.
- The tournament takes place every four years. Matches are played between two teams of 11 players. Each match is played over 1 day - so we call it a One-Dayer.
- The teams are split into two groups of 7 teams each, called pools. Each team plays 6 games across the 14 different venues. Once all of the teams in each pool have played each other, the top four teams in each pool will progress to the Quarter Finals.
- The four winners of those sudden-death matches will play off in the semi-finals, before the final is held on Sunday 29th March at the MCG in Melbourne.
