HOCKEY

The game is played on a rectangular 'turf'. Games last (up to) 70 minutes between two teams of eleven players. Players 'dribble' the ball with 'hooked' sticks to move it down towards the goal net. The aim of the game is to score a goal by hitting the ball into the goal that is guarded by the opposing team's goal keeper. The team that has scored the most goals at the end of the game is the winner!

The best part is having fun with your mates!

RUGBY

There are 15 players on each team. The aim of the game is to score points by scoring a try (5 points), a conversion goal (2 points), a penalty goal (3 points) or a dropped goal (3 points). A player may receive the ball from a teammate via a pass only if they are behind them and then advance the ball by running with it. The aim is to score a try at the other end of the field. The field is a rectangle 70 metres wide and 100 metres long.

SOCCER

The game is played on a rectangular pitch with a goal area and goal at each end. There are two teams each consisting of up to 11 players - one being the designated goalie. The aim of the game is to score a goal by kicking or heading the ball into the other team's goal. The team that has scored the most goals at the end of the game is the winner.

NETBALL

Netball is played over four 15 minute quarters. Each team has seven players - each player is given a position and is only allowed in some areas of the court. The game starts with a centre pass - this alternates between the teams after each goal. A goal is awarded when either the goal shooter or goal attack shoots a goal through the goal ring. One point is awarded for each goal and the winner is the team with the most goals at the final whistle.
